

## **The 6R4.com Three Sisters Rally Challenge 2016 Regulations.**

1. Wigan & District Motor Club and Blackpool South Shore Motor Club, will co-promote the above Rally Challenge in accordance with the General Regulations of RAC the Motor Sports Association United Kingdom, (Incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), and these 6R4.com Three Sisters Rally Challenge 2016 Regulations.
2. The 6R4.com Three Sisters Rally Challenge 2016 will consist of all three Special Stage Rallies organised by the above clubs, at The Three Sisters Race Circuit, Ashton in Makerfield, Nr. Wigan, Lancashire.
3. The Rally Challenge is open to all members of the organising clubs, plus ANCC, ANWCC, AWMMC & SD34MSG. The championship registration number is 53/2016.
4. The Three Special Stage Rallies will take place on these dates, The Roskirk Stages Sunday 13th March 2016, The Cetus Solutions Stages Sunday 8<sup>th</sup>. May 2016, and The Adgespeed Stages Sunday 9th October 2016.
5. A potential prize fund of £550.00 is there to be won, to qualify for any cash awards Drivers & Co-Drivers will need to enter at least two out of the three rallies and display on their cars the supplied sponsors decals.
6. To be The 6R4.com Three Sisters Rally Challenge Champion Driver or Champion Co-Driver you will need to enter all three of the rallies.
7. Drivers and Co-Drivers entering the above events will automatically be registered for The 6R4.com Three Sisters Rally Challenge 2016.

9. The results will be declared provisional for seven days after the results for each round are posted on the Wigan & DMC and the ANWCC web sites, they will then be declared final. It is the competitors responsibility to check your own results.
10. The eligibility Scrutineer is Mr. Christopher Mansley MSA National A.
11. The five classes for The 6R4.com Three Sisters Rally Challenge 2016 will be:-
  - A. Cars with engines up to 1000cc.
  - B. Cars with engines 1001cc - 1400cc.
  - C. Cars with engines 1401cc – 1600cc.
  - D. Cars with engines 1601cc - 2000cc.
  - E. Cars with engines 2001cc and over.A minimum of five cars in the class constitute a class win.  
Classes can be amalgamated at the organiser's discretion.

**N.B.** Engine capacities will be actual capacities. Cars with forced induction and rotary engine cars, regulation **R 48.2.4**, will apply and have their engine capacities multiplied by 1.7 to determine their class. All vehicles must comply with M.S.A. Technical Regulations for special stage rallies with due attention to **R 46 - R 48.10.10**.

**Turbo anti-lag systems must be disconnected to comply with the circuit requirements.**

12. FUEL – This Championship has been granted permission for competitors to use pump fuels complying with FIA Appendix J, Article 252, Article. 9.
13. There are no registration fees for competing in, The 6R4.com Three Sisters Rally Challenge 2016. The onus is on the competitors to get their entries in early to avoid any disappointment.
14. Class winners will be actual class winners excluding overall placing's, £15 will be awarded to every class winning Driver & Co-Driver in each of the three Special Stage Rallies, subject to a minimum number of cars in each class, as published in each of the rallies regulations. To qualify for any cash awards competitors must enter at least two out of the three rallies.
15. The Driver & Co-Driver of The 6R4.com Three Sisters Rally Challenge 2016 will be presented with perpetual awards plus replicas to the Driver & Co-Driver. These will be awarded to the Driver & Co-Driver with the lowest number of points; one point is awarded for each overall place. The overall Champion Driver & Champion Co-Driver will also receive a cash award of £50.00 each.
16. Points can be scored in all of three rallies, 1 point for 1<sup>st</sup>. overall, 2 points for 2<sup>nd</sup>. Overall etc. the driver & co-driver with the lowest number of points without out a DNS, DNF or DNE over the three rallies will be declared the Challenge winners.  
DNS = Did not start.                      DNF = Did not finish.                      DNE = Did not enter.
17. In the event of a tie for the overall placings, regulation R15.2.2 will apply with respect to, The 6R4.com Three Sisters Rally Challenge 2016.
