

## **The 6r4.com Three Sisters Rally Challenge 2020 Regulations.**

1. Wigan & District Motor Club and Warrington & District Motor Club, will co-promote the above Rally Challenge in accordance with the General Regulations of Motorsport UK, (Incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), and these 6r4.com Three Sisters Rally Challenge 2020 Regulations.
2. The 6r4.com Three Sisters Rally Challenge 2020 will consist of all three Special Stage Rallies organised by the above clubs, at The Three Sisters Race Circuit, Ashton in Makerfield, Nr. Wigan, Lancashire.
3. The Rally Challenge is open to all members of the organising clubs, plus ANCC, ANWCC, AWMCC & SD34MSG. The Motorsport UK permit number is 60/2020.
4. The Three Special Stage Rallies will take place on the following dates:- Questmead Stages Sunday 1st March 2020, CompBrake Stages Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> May 2020, and Adgespeed Stages Sunday 11th October 2020.
5. A prize fund of £450.00 is there to be won, to qualify for any cash awards Drivers & Co-Drivers will need to enter all of the three rallies and display on their cars the supplied sponsors decals.
6. To be The 6r4.com Three Sisters Rally Challenge Champion Driver or Champion Co-Driver you will need to enter all three of the rallies and display all the sponsors decals which will be supplied by the organisers.
7. Drivers and Co-Drivers wishing to enter in the challenge should register their interest in competing in The 6r4.com Three Sisters Rally Challenge 2020, at the first rally, Questmead Stages.

9. The results will be declared provisional for seven days after the results for each round are posted on the Wigan & DMC and the ANWCC web sites, they will then be declared final. It is the competitor's responsibility to check your own results.
10. The eligibility Scrutineer is Mr. Christopher Mansley Motorsport UK National A.
11. The four classes for The 6r4.com Three Sisters Rally Challenge 2019 will be:-  
A. Cars with engines up to - 1400cc.      B. Cars with engines 1401cc – 1600cc.  
C. Cars with engines 1601cc - 2000cc.      D. Cars with engines 2001cc and over.  
Classes can be amalgamated at the organiser's discretion.

**N.B.** Engine capacities will be actual capacities. Cars with forced induction and rotary engine cars, regulation **R 48.2.4**. will apply and have their engine capacities multiplied by 1.7 to determine their class. All vehicles must comply with Motorsport UK Technical Regulations for special stage rallies with due attention to **R 46 - R 48.10.10**.

**Turbo anti-lag systems must be disconnected to comply with the circuit requirements.**

12. There is no registration fee for competing in The 6r4.com Three Sisters Rally Challenge 2020. The onus is on the competitors to register their interest at the first round and get their entries in early to avoid any disappointment.
13. The 1<sup>st</sup> Overall Driver & Co-Driver will each receive £100.00.  
The Driver & Co-Driver of The 6r4.com Three Sisters Rally Challenge 2020 will be presented with perpetual awards plus replicas. These cash awards will be awarded to the Drivers & Co-Drivers with the highest number of points.  
The 2<sup>nd</sup> Overall Driver & Co-Driver will each receive £75.00.  
The 3<sup>rd</sup> Overall Driver & Co-Driver will each receive £50.00.
14. Overall, Driver & Co-Driver: - 75 points for 1<sup>st</sup>. Overall, 74 points for 2<sup>nd</sup>. Overall etc. down to 1 point for 75<sup>th</sup>. Overall.  
To be added to the Overall points totals: - No extra points will be added to Class D 2001cc and above including turbocharged cars.  
The average Overall class winning position of Class C is 3 so 3 points will be added to the total points scored.  
The average Overall class winning position of Class B is 6 so 6 points will be added to the total points scored.  
The average Overall class winning position of Class A is 17 so 17 points will be added to the total points scored.  
This system is based on the last 18 known results at Three Sisters Race Circuit and will give everybody a fair chance of winning The 6r4.com Three Sisters Rally Challenge 2020 irrespective of what class of car is being used to compete in.
15. Overall the Driver & Co-Driver with the highest number of points over the three rallies will be declared the Challenge winners. In the event of a tie for the overall placings, regulation R15.2.2 will apply with respect to, The 6r4.com Three Sisters Rally Challenge 2020.
16. The 6R4.com Three Sisters Rally Challenge 2020 stewards are:- David Hind & Stephen Ellison.
